RED MERITAGE: PRISONER

Rich ruby red color, alluring aromas of cherry and plum draw you in to a flavor of lush blueberries, cherries and cocoa. A soft, velvety touch of a finish awaits.

GABERNET SAUVIGNON: CUTTINGS

Luscious and round with alluring aromas of black cherry and roasted herbs. The palette is savory and structured with flavors of robust black fruit, currant, and espresso. Ripe plum and peppery spice alongside complex tannins evolve into a delicate finish.

GABERNET SAUVIGNON: JORDAN

Aromas of blackberry, blueberry and cassis mingle with hints of violet and dark chocolate to seduce and intrigue.

GABERNET SAUVIGNON: STAG'S LEAP

This Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon opens with generous dark cherry, juicy plum, currant and cassis, while accents of black pepper and chocolate give it a classic feel. Seamlessly integrated oak and refined tannins provide wonderful texture while the bright, fresh fruit flavors balance the wine's impressive concentration.

MERLOT: DUCK HORN

Displays intense aromas of ripe cherry, followed by more nuanced elements of cedar, sweet spices, orange peel and cigar box. On the palate, layers of black raspberry and spiced plum mingle more savory notes of nutmeg. With integrated tannins that extend the finish, this beautifully structured Merlot promises great age ability.

MERLOT: THORN

Aromas of savory spice, black cherry, and mocha with cedar and blackberry. The entry delivers an elegant balance with flavors of black plum and anise, along with hints of grilled rosemary and toasted oak. Velvety, chocolate tannin's develop into a robust finish.

PINOT NOIR: CHEHELAM - THREE VINEYARD

Big Bold Balanced Beautiful... Dark, deep garnet, with a rich nose of black currants, blackberries and peppery earth. Luxuriously layered flavors of the like lead to a lengthy, focused finish

ZINFANDEL: SALDO

dark ruby color with bold aromas of blackberry, plum and clove. The entry is rich and full, with juicy acidity encircled in flavors of Mexican chocolate, cherry and vanilla extract. There is a voluptuous and persistent finish with smooth tannins.
